ಪದವಿ ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಪ್ರಥಮ ವರ್ಷದ ತರಗತಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಪ್ರವೇಶದಲ್ಲಿ ಹೆಚ್ಚಿನ ಪಾರದರ್ಶಕತೆ ತರುವ  
ಸದುದ್ದೇಶದಿಂದ ಈ ಕಛೇರಿ ಮಾರ್ಗಸೂಚಿಯನ್ನು ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣ ಕಾಯ್ದೆ ಮತ್ತು ಸುಪ್ರೀಮ್ ಕೋರ್ಟಿನ ತೀರ್ಪಿನ  
ಆಧಾರದ ಮೇಲೆ ಸಿದ್ಧಪಡಿಸಲಾಗಿದೆ. ಇದನ್ನು 2003-2004ನೇ ಶೈಕ್ಷಣಿಕ ಸಾಲಿನಿಂದ ಪ್ರಥಮ ವರ್ಷದ ಪದವಿ ತರಗತಿಗಳಿಗೆ  
ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳನ್ನು ದಾಖಲಾತಿ ಮಾಡಿಕೊಳ್ಳುವಾಗ ಸರ್ಕಾರಿ ಹಾಗೂ ಖಾಸಗಿ ಅನುದಾನಿತ ಮತ್ತು ಖಾಸಗಿ ಅನುದಾನಿತ  
ಅಲ್ಪಸಂಖ್ಯಾತ ಸಂಸ್ಥೆಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಕಡ್ಡಾಯವಾಗಿ ಪಾಲಿಸಲು ಸೂಚಿಸಲಾಗಿದೆ.

1. ತಮ್ಮ ಕಾಲೇಜಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಪ್ರಥಮ ವರ್ಷದ ಪದವಿ ತರಗತಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಲಭ್ಯವಿರುವ ಒಟ್ಟು ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳ  
ಸಂಖ್ಯೆಯನ್ನು ಸೂಚನಾಫಲಕದ ಮೇಲೆ / ವೆಬ್‌ಸೈಟ್‌ನಲ್ಲಿ ದಾಖಲಾತಿ ಪ್ರಕ್ರಿಯೆ  
ಪ್ರಾರಂಭವಾಗುವ ಮಾದಲು ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬೇಕು. ಈ ಪ್ರವೇಶ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆಯನ್ನು  
ಸಂಯೋಜನೆವಾರು ರೋಸ್ಟರ್ ಪದ್ಧತಿ ಪ್ರಕಾರ ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬೇಕು. ಪ್ರತಿ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆಯಲ್ಲಿ  
ಎಷ್ಟು ವರ್ಗಗಳು (Sections) ಇರುತ್ತವೆ ಎಂಬುದನ್ನು ನಮೂದಿಸಬೇಕು. ಈ ರೀತಿಯಲ್ಲಿ  
ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಿರುವ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆಗಳಿಗೆ / ವರ್ಗಗಳಿಗೆ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದಿಂದ ಅನುಮತಿ  
ಪಡೆದಿರಬೇಕು. ಆಯಾ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ನಿಗದಿ ಪಡಿಸಿದ ಪ್ರಕಾರ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳನ್ನು  
ಮಾತ್ರ ದಾಖಲಾತಿ ಮಾಡಿಕೊಳ್ಳಬೇಕು. ಸೂಚನಾಫಲಕದ ಮೇಲೆ ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬಹುದಾದ  
ಮಾಹಿತಿಗೆ ಒಂದು ಉದಾಹರಣೆ ಕೊಡಲಾಗಿದೆ.

1. ಕಾಲೇಜಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಭೋಧನೆ ಮಾಡುವ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆಗಳು ಹಾಗೂ ಪ್ರತಿ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆಯಲ್ಲಿರುವ ವಿಷಯಗಳು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ನಿಗದಿಪಡಿಸಿರುವ ಪಠ್ಯಕ್ರಮದಲ್ಲಿರುವ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆಗಳ ಗುಂಪಿನಲ್ಲಿರಬೇಕು. ಸರ್ಕಾರದ ಅನುಮತಿ ಇಲ್ಲದೆ ಯಾವುದೇ ಸರ್ಕಾರಿ ಪದವಿ ಕಾಲೇಜಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಹೊಸದಾಗಿ ವಿಷಯವನ್ನಾಗಲಿ ಅಥವಾ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆಯನ್ನಾಗಲಿ ಪ್ರಾರಂಭಿಸಬಾರದು ಹಾಗೂ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳನ್ನು ದಾಖಲಾತಿ ಮಾಡಿಕೊಳ್ಳಬಾರದು. ಇಲಾಖೆಯ ಲಿಖಿತ ಪೂರ್ವಾನುಮತಿ ಇಲ್ಲದೇ ಕಾಲೇಜಿನ ಹೆಚ್ಚುವರಿ ಉಪನ್ಯಾಸಕರಿಗೆ ಕಾರ್ಯಭಾರ ಹಂಚಿಕೆ ಮಾಡುವ ದೃಷ್ಟಿಯಿಂದ ಮಾಧ್ಯಮವಾರು (Medium wise) ತರಗತಿಗಳನ್ನು ಪ್ರಾರಂಭಿಸಬಾರದು.
2. ಪ್ರಥಮ ಪದವಿ ತರಗತಿಗಳಿಗೆ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳನ್ನು ದಾಖಲಾತಿ ಮಾಡಿಕೊಳ್ಳಲು ಆಯಾ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯಗಳ ವೇಳಾಪಟ್ಟಿಯನ್ನು ಅನುಸರಿಸಬೇಕು. ದಾಖಲಾತಿಯ ಪೂರ್ಣ ವೇಳಾಪಟ್ಟಿಯನ್ನು (Calendar of events for admission) ಕಾಲೇಜಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಪ್ರಮುಖವಾದ ಸ್ಥಳದಲ್ಲಿ ಪೋಷಕರ/ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳ ಗಮನಕ್ಕಾಗಿ ಕಡ್ಡಾಯವಾಗಿ ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬೇಕು.





1. ಪಿ ಯು ಸಿ ಪರೀಕ್ಷಾ ಫಲಿತಾಂಶ ಪ್ರಕಟವಾದ ಮಾರನೇ ದಿವಸದಿಂದ ಕನಿಷ್ಠ ಐದು ದಿನಗಳ ಕಾಲ ಪ್ರವೇಶ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ದೊರಕುವಂತೆ ಏರ್ಪಾಡು ಮಾಡಬೇಕು. (ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಕ್ರಮ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆಯಿರಬೇಕು) ಪ್ರತಿ ದಿವಸ ಕನಿಷ್ಠ ನಾಲ್ಕು ಗಂಟೆಗಳ ಕಾಲ ಪ್ರವೇಶ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳು ದೊರಕಲು ವ್ಯವಸ್ಥೆ ಮಾಡಬೇಕು. ಯಾವ ಸಮಯದಲ್ಲಿ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಕೊಡಲಾಗುವುದು ಎಂಬುದನ್ನು ಪೂರ್ವಭಾವಿಯಾಗಿ ಸೂಚನಾಫಲಕ/ಕಪ್ಪು ಹಲಗೆಯ ಮೇಲೆ ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬೇಕು. ಅವಶ್ಯಕತೆ ಕಂಡುಬಂದಲ್ಲಿ ಹೆಚ್ಚಿನ ಕೌಂಟರ್ಸ್ ತೆಗೆದು ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಸುಲಭವಾಗಿ ದೊರಕುವಂತೆ ಏರ್ಪಾಡು ಮಾಡಬೇಕು.
2. ಪ್ರವೇಶ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ವಿತರಿಸಲು ವೇಳಾಪಟ್ಟಿಯಂತೆ ಕೊನೆಯ ದಿನಾಂಕವಾದ ನಂತರ ಮೂರು ದಿವಸಗಳ ಸಮಯವನ್ನು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಂದ ಭರ್ತಿ ಮಾಡಿದ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ಹಿಂದಕ್ಕೆ ಪಡೆಯಲು ಕೊನೆಯ ದಿನಾಂಕದೊಳಗಾಗಿ ಕೊಡಬೇಕು. ಭರ್ತಿ ಮಾಡಿದ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಂದ ಪಡೆಯಲು ಪ್ರತ್ಯೇಕ ಕೌಂಟರ್ಸ್ ತೆಗೆಯಬೇಕು. ಪ್ರತಿದಿವಸ ಕನಿಷ್ಠ ನಾಲ್ಕು ಗಂಟೆಗಳ ಸಮಯ ಈ ಕೌಂಟರ್ಸ್ ತೆಗೆದಿರಬೇಕು. ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ವಿತರಿಸಲು ಪ್ರಾರಂಭ ಮಾಡಿದ ಮಾರನೆಯ ದಿವಸದಿಂದ ಭರ್ತಿ ಮಾಡಿದ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಂದ ಹಿಂದಕ್ಕೆ ಪಡೆಯಬಹುದು.
3. ಪ್ರತಿ ದಿವಸ ಎಷ್ಟು ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ಮಾರಾಟ ಮಾಡಲಾಯಿತು ಎಂಬುದಕ್ಕೆ ಲೆಕ್ಕ ಇಡಬೇಕು. ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಕೊಡುವಾಗಲೇ ಗಣಕೀಕರಣ ಮಾಡಿಕೊಂಡಲ್ಲಿ ಮುಂದೆ ಅವಶ್ಯವಾದ ಮಾಹಿತಿಯನ್ನು ಸೇರಿಸಲು ಸುಲಭವಾಗುತ್ತದೆ. ದಾಖಲಾತಿ ಪ್ರಕ್ರಿಯೆಯ ಕೊನೆಯಲ್ಲಿ ಕೋರ್ಸು ವಾರು, ಕಾಂಬಿನೇಷನ್ ವಾರು ಒಟ್ಟು ದಾಖಲಾದ ಅಂಕಿ ಅಂಶಗಳನ್ನು ಸಂಬಂಧಪಟ್ಟ ಪ್ರಾದೇಶಿಕ ಜಂಟಿ ನಿರ್ದೇಶಕರ ಕಛೇರಿಗೆ ಜುಲೈ ಮೊದಲನೇ ವಾರದಲ್ಲಿ ಕಳುಹಿಸಿಕೊಡಬೇಕು.
4. ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ಸ್ವೀಕರಿಸುವುದಕ್ಕೆ ಸ್ವೀಕೃತಿ ಪತ್ರ ನೀಡಬೇಕು. ಪ್ರಥಮ ಪದವಿ ತರಗತಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಕಾಲೇಜಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಪ್ರವೇಶಕ್ಕೆ ಅರ್ಜಿಗಳನ್ನು ಹಾಕಿದ ಅರ್ಹ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳ ಪೂರ್ಣ ಪಟ್ಟಿಯನ್ನು ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣ ಕಾಯ್ದೆ 1995 (ದಿ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಎಜುಕೇಷನ್ ಇನ್ ಸ್ಟಿಟ್ಯೂಷನ್ಸ್, ಕ್ಲಾಸಿಫಿಕೇಷನ್, ರೆವಿಲೇಷನ್ ಮತ್ತು ಪ್ರಿನ್ಸಿಪಲ್ಸ್ ಆಫ್ ಕ್ಯಾರಿಕೂಲಾ ಎಕ್ಸಾಟ್ಸಾ ನಿಯಮಗಳು 1995) ನಿಯಮ 14 (11)ರ ಪ್ರಕಾರ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆವಾರು ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬೇಕು. ಪದವಿ ತರಗತಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಸೇರಲು ಅರ್ಹರಲ್ಲದ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳು ಅರ್ಜಿ ಹಾಕಿದ್ದ ಪಕ್ಷದಲ್ಲಿ ಅಂತಹ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳ ತಿರಸ್ಕೃತ ಪಟ್ಟಿಯನ್ನು ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬೇಕು. ಈ ಎರಡು ಪಟ್ಟಿಗಳನ್ನು (ಅರ್ಹಪಟ್ಟಿ



ಮತ್ತು ತಿರಸ್ಕೃತ ಪಟ್ಟಿ) ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಿದ ಮೇಲೆ ಇದರ ಬಗ್ಗೆ ಏನಾದರೂ ಆಕ್ಷೇಪಣೆ ಇದ್ದ ಪಕ್ಷದಲ್ಲಿ ಐದು ದಿವಸದೊಳಗೆ ಅರ್ಜಿಯನ್ನು ಹಾಕಲು ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಅವಕಾಶ ಮಾಡಿಕೊಡಬೇಕು.

5. ಅ) ಸರ್ಕಾರಿ ಪದವಿ ಕಾಲೇಜಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಲಭ್ಯವಿರುವ ಎಲ್ಲ ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ಮೆರಿಟ್ ಆಧಾರದ ಮೇಲೆ ರೋಸ್ಟರ್ ಪದ್ಧತಿಯಂತೆ ಹಂಚಿಕೆ ಮಾಡಬೇಕು.
- ಆ) ಖಾಸಗಿ ಅನುದಾನಿತ ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಲಭ್ಯವಿರುವ ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ನಿಯಮ 12(ಬಿ) ಪ್ರಕಾರ ಸಂಯೋಜನೆವಾರು ಶೇಕಡ 20 ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ಹಂಚಲು ಸಂಸ್ಥೆಯವರಿಗೆ ಬಿಡಲಾಗಿದೆ. ಆದರೆ ಸಾಧ್ಯವಾದಷ್ಟು ಮಟ್ಟಿಗೆ ರೋಸ್ಟರ್ ಪದ್ಧತಿಯಂತೆ ಪ್ರವೇಶ ನಿರ್ವಹಿಸತಕ್ಕದ್ದು.

ಇನ್ನುಳಿದ ಶೇಕಡ 80 ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ಸಂಯೋಜನೆವಾರ ಮೀಸಲಾತಿ ಪದ್ಧತಿಯಂತೆ ಮತ್ತು ಕೇವಲ ಮೆರಿಟ್ ಆಧಾರದ ಮೇಲೆ ಹಂಚಿಕೆ ಮಾಡಬೇಕು.

- ಇ) ಅಲ್ಪಸಂಖ್ಯಾತ ಅನುದಾನಿತ ಸಂಸ್ಥೆಯವರು ನಡೆಸುತ್ತಿರುವ ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಒಟ್ಟು ಲಭ್ಯವಿರುವ ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಶೇಕಡ 50 ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ತಮ್ಮದೇ ಆದ ಜನಾಂಗದ (ಕಮ್ಯೂನಿಟಿ) ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳಿಗೆ ಹಂಚಿಕೆ ಮಾಡಲು ಸಂಸ್ಥೆಯವರಿಗೆ ಬಿಡಲಾಗಿದೆ. ಇನ್ನುಳಿದ 50 ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ನಿಯಮಾವಳಿ 14ರ ಉಪನಿಯಮಾವಳಿ 05 ಮತ್ತು 06ರಂತೆ ರೋಸ್ಟರ್ ಪದ್ಧತಿಯಂತೆ ಮೆರಿಟ್ ಮೇಲೆ ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ಹಂಚಬೇಕು. ಹೀಗೆ ಪ್ರವೇಶಗಳನ್ನು ಕೊಟ್ಟ ಎರಡು ಪಟ್ಟಿಗಳನ್ನು ಪ್ರತ್ಯೇಕವಾಗಿ ಪ್ರಕಟಿಸಬೇಕು. ಖಾಸಗಿ ಅನುದಾನಿತ ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳಿಗೆ ನಿಯಮ 12(ಬಿ) ಪ್ರಕಾರ ಲಭ್ಯವಿರುವ ಶೇಕಡ 20 (ಸಂಸ್ಥೆಯವರು ಮಾಡಬಹುದಾದ) ಪ್ರವೇಶವನ್ನು ನೀಡುವಾಗ ಸದರಿ ಪ್ರವೇಶದಲ್ಲಿಯೂ ಸಹ ಅದಷ್ಟು ಮಟ್ಟಿಗೆ ಅರ್ಥದಷ್ಟು ಪ್ರವೇಶ ಸೀಟುಗಳನ್ನು ತನ್ನದೇ ಆದ ಅಲ್ಪಸಂಖ್ಯಾತ ಪಂಗಡಕ್ಕೂ ಹಾಗೂ ಇನ್ನೂಳಿದ ಅರ್ಥದಷ್ಟು ಪ್ರವೇಶ ಸೀಟುಗಳನ್ನು ಅದಷ್ಟು ಮಟ್ಟಿಗೆ ಸರ್ಕಾರ ನಿಗದಿ ಪಡಿಸಿರುವ ಮೀಸಲಾತಿ ಪದ್ಧತಿಯಂತೆ ಪ್ರವೇಶ ನೀಡುವ ವ್ಯವಸ್ಥೆ ಮಾಡತಕ್ಕದ್ದು.



**Notice**

**Subject: Regarding more transparency in Admission to Degree colleges for first year Degree classes.**

Following guideline has been issued to bring more transparency for the admission of first year degree classes in Degree colleges based on the Karnataka Education Act and the Supreme Court's order. It is mandatory to adhere to government, private aided and private unaided minority institutions while enrolling students for first year degree classes from 2003-2004.

i. The total number of seats available for first-year degree classes at their colleges should be published on Notice Board / Website before the start of admission process. This admission number should be published combination wise as per the roster system. Specify number of sections in each combination. College should get affiliation from university for such kind of combinations/sections published. Admission should be given to the students as per the University specifications only. Here is an example of information that can be published on the Notice Board.

1. Teaching combinations in college and each subject in combination should be in the university specified combination group. No government degree college should start and give admission to student of any subject or combination without the permission of the government. With the intention to distribution of workload to additional faculty members in the colleges medium wise classes should not be started without prior written permission from the department.
2. The enrollment of students for first degree classes must be as per the respective Universities schedule. The Calendar of events for admission must be displayed at prominent place in the college for parent's/student's attention.
3. Admission application forms must be made available to the students at least five days from the date of declaration of PUC exam result. (Application forms must be serially numbered). Entry applications must be arranged for at least four hours each day. Time of distribution of application forms to the students should be published in advance on a Notice-board/blackboard of the college. If necessary, more counters should be arranged for easy availability of application forms to the students.
4. Three days time period should be given to the students for the submission of filled application forms from the last date of distribution. A separate counter must be arranged for





- getting filled application forms from the students. Such counters should be open at least four hours in each day. Filled application can be get back from the next day of forms distribution to the students.
5. You have to account for how many applications were sold each day. It is easier to add the necessary information if the applications are computerized to the students. By the end of the enrollment process, the total enrollment figures for the course and combination should be sent to the Regional Joint Director's Office in the first week of July.
  6. Students must receive an acknowledgment letter to accept applications. The full list of eligible students applying for admission to college for first degree classes should be published in terms of Rule 14 (11) of Karnataka Education Act 1995 (The Karnataka Educational Inspirations Classification, Regulation and Prescription of Caricola Exotna Rules 1995). Students who are not eligible for admission to graduate classes rejected list should be published. Student from these lists should be allowed to apply again within five days if there is any objection to this rejection publication.

#### Methods of seat allocation

5. A. All available admissions in Government Degree College should be allocated on merit basis as roster system.
- b. According to Rule 12 (b), the institution can allocate a combined 20 per cent of the admissions in the private aided colleges. But as much as possible, the roster system should be followed.

The remaining 80 percent of admissions are combined with the reservation system and allotment should be made on the basis of merit only.

- c. Fifty percent of the total admissions in colleges run by a aided minority institution are left to the institution to distribute to students of their own people (community). The remaining 50 entries must be allocated on merit as a roster system of subsection 05 and 06 of regulation 14. The two lists that are granted entries must be published separately. The provision of 20 per cent (institutional) access to private aided colleges in accordance with Rule 12 (b) shall be the same as that of the Government-reserved system of admissions to the extent of half its admissions to its own minority and half of its admissions.

Admissions can be made even after the completion of the calendar of events mentioned above. Admission to the first degree classes determined by the University will be permitted to enroll within the last date of enrollment.



### **Roaster Distribution:**

1. 50% of admissions in co-education institutions should be reserved for girl students under Rule 14 (6). Again roaster system should be followed among these girl students. If 50 per cent of girl students do not apply, the admissions can be given to the students (boys) on the roster system.
2. 05 per cent of the total admissions should be reserved for the disabled in terms of section 39 of the Disability Act 1995.
3. Provision of admission to students of Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes / Backward categories category-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB, students as per Rule 4 (5) as stipulated by the Government.
4. Transfer of such admissions to the general category if the relevant students in different categories do not apply. Applications from the reserved category for any reason shall not be transferred to the general category without exhausting.

### **Preparation of Admission List based on merit-**

At first admissions must be filled on a merit basis, including students who are subject to reservation. After determining which group of admissions should be allocated based on the above mentioned reservation system, the students of the respective tribes should apply on the basis of merit based on the merit of the students (admissions based on the marks scored by the students on the PUC test or the equivalent test). The college shall publish the first list, the secondary list, the third list and additional lists, if necessary, in accordance with subsection 11 and 12A. The dates of publication of lists must have the following periods.

After publishing the first list of selected students in accordance with subsection 12A, students must be given three days to pay the fees. The second list should be published on the fifth day after the first list is published, ensuring how many students has been charged. Students of this second selected list of should also be given three days of time to pay the fee. The Third selected list should be published five days after secondary list is published. They should also be given three days of time to pay the fees. If necessary, additional list should be published 5 days after third list is published. For any reason names not included in the four lists should be not be allowed for getting admission to first year degree classes

In each selected list, students must enter the total marks and percentage points obtained in the PUC or equivalent examination. For any reason only certain subject points should not be taken into consideration. Total marks and percentage of marks of admitted students should be published on notice board.





Selected lists and lists of enrolled students must be sent to the Regional Joint Director's office to confirm upon completion of the admissions process.

Fees structure of the college must be published on the notice board. Receipt should be given for the fees collected.

Preamble:

In Govt. Order Dated: 17-09-94 read (1) above, Govt. have formulated reservation policy for Schedule Casts and Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes for admissions to professional courses for the year 1994-95 as per the lists of castes enclosed thereto as follows:

CATEGORY-I	4%	} OBC
CATEGORY-II (A)	15%	
CATEGORY-II (B)	4%	
CATEGORY-III (A)	4%	
CATEGORY-III (B)	5%	
SCHEDULED CASTES	15%	
SCHEDULED TRIBES	3%	

2. Under the said order Dated: 17-09-94 It has also been stated that no person other than belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Category-I of Backward Classes shall be entitled to the benefit of reservation for admission to professional courses unless he/she satisfies the conditions of the creamy layer specified there under.
3. In G.O. Dated: 31-01-1995 read at Sl. No. 2 above, the aforesaid reservation and creamy layer policy envisaged in the order Dated: 17-09-94 read at Sl. No. (1), has been made applicable to the employment too, under Article 16(4) of the Constitution of India.
4. In G.O. Dated: 14-02-96 read at Sl. No. (3) above the Creamy Layer Policy existed as on 01-01-95 for the purpose of admission to the professional courses was also made applicable to employment with retrospective effect from 01-01-94.
5. In Writ Petition No. 438/94 the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India have passed an interim order stating that the reservation in any case should not exceed 50%. Similar writs bearing No. 417/94, and 694/94 are pending disposal before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Therefore, in G.O. No. SWD 61 BCA 95 Dated: 28-12-95 the currency of the 50% reservation specified in G.O. Dated: 17-09-94 and 13-01-95 has been extended till the final decision in WP No. 438/94, 471/94 and 694/94 is taken by Hon'ble Supreme Court.
6. Now the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes have submitted special report and 71 advices vide their letter Dated: 04-12-2000 read at Sl. No. 4 above. Pending consideration of the entire report, the Government have examined in detail the Creamy Layer Policy contained in the Special Report and 71 Advices, relating to Inclusions, deletions, correction of spellings etc. and have made the following orders.





Government Order No. SWD 225 BCA 2000, Dated: 30th March 2002

After careful consideration of the above proposal the Government are pleased to make the following orders:

1. The quantum of Reservation Specified in G.O. Dated: 17-09-1984 and 31-01-1995 read at Sl. No. (1) & (2) respectively is continued for admission to Educational Institutions and Employment.
2. The revised list of Backward Classes enclosed to this order as at Annexure-I, incorporating recommendations of the BC Commission, is brought into force with immediate effect.
3. A new comprehensive Creamy Layer Policy as detailed in Annexure-II to this Government order is brought into force with immediate effect. This Creamy Layer Policy does not apply to SCs/STs and Category-I of the Backward Classes. Candidates belonging to Category-II(A), II(B), III(A), and III(B) shall be entitled to reservation in the manner specified in the new comprehensive Creamy Layer Policy.

## THE KARNATAKA STATE COMMISSION FOR BACKWARD CLASSES ACT, 1995.

*(Received the assent of the Governor on the Twelfth day of October 1995)**(As amended by Karnataka Act No. 24 of 1997)*

An Act to constitute a Commission for Backward Classes of Citizens other than the Schedule Castes and the Schedule Tribes in the State of Karnataka and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto;

Whereas it is expedient to constitute a Commission for Backward Classes of Citizens other than the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in the State of Karnataka and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto;

Be it enacted by the Karnataka State Legislature in the Forty-sixth year of the Republic of India as follows :-

## CHAPTER - I

## PRELIMINARY

1. **Short title and Commencement.**- (1) This Act may be called the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1995.

(2) It shall come into force on such date, as the State Government may, by notification<sup>1</sup> appoint.

2. **Definitions.**- In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-

(a) "Backward Classes" means such class or classes of Citizens other than the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, as may be notified by the State Government in the list from time to time;

(b) "Commission" means the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes constituted under section 3;

(c) "Lists" means lists prepared by the State Government, from time to time; for purposes of making provisions for the reservation in favour of Backward Classes of citizens under Article 15(4) and Article 16(4) of the Constitution;

(d) "Member" means a member of the Commission.

## CHAPTER II

## CONSTITUTION OF THE KARNATAKA STATE COMMISSION FOR BACKWARD CLASSES

3. **Constitution of the Karnataka Commission for Backward Classes.**- (1) The Government shall constitute a body to be known as the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes to exercise the powers conferred on and to perform the functions assigned to it under this Act with its headquarters at Bangalore.

(2) The Commission shall consist of the following members:-

(a) a Chairman, who is or has been a Judge of the High Court<sup>1</sup> or who is eligible to be appointed as a Judge of the High Court or a Social Scientist;

(b)<sup>2</sup> (omitted)

1. The Act has come into force with effect from 01.12.1997 vide Government Notification No SWD/64 DCA 97 dt:29.11.1997





(c)<sup>2</sup> five persons who have special knowledge in matters relating to Backward Classes of whom one shall be a social scientist, nominated by the State Government and :-

(d) the Director, Backward Classes and Minorities Department, shall be the Member Secretary of the Commission.

4. **Term of office and conditions of service of Chairman and Members.**- (1) Subject to the pleasure of the State Government the Chairman and every member shall hold office for the term of three years from the date he assumes office\*.

(2) The Chairman or a member may in writing under his hand addressed to the State Government, resign from the office of Chairman or of member, as the case be, at any time.

(3) The State Government shall remove a person from the office of the Chairman or of a member if that person,-

(a) becomes an undischarged insolvent;

(b) is convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which, in the opinion of the State Government, involves moral turpitude;

(c) becomes of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court;

(d) refuses to act or becomes incapable of acting;

(e) is, without obtaining leave of absence from the Commission, absent from three consecutive meetings of the Commission; or

(f) has, in the opinion of the Government so abused the position of Chairman or Member as to render that person's continuance in office is detrimental to the interests of backward classes or the public interest.

Provided that no person shall be removed under this clause until that person has been given an opportunity of being heard in the matter.

(4) A vacancy caused under sub-section (2) or otherwise shall be filled by fresh nomination.

(5) The salaries and allowances payable to and the other terms and conditions of service of, the Chairman and Members shall be such, as may be prescribed.

5. **Officers and other employees of the Commission.**- (1) The State Government shall provide the Commission with such officers and employees, as may be necessary for the efficient performance of the functions of the Commission.

(2) The salaries and allowances payable to and the other terms and conditions of service of the officers and other employees appointed for the purpose of the Commission shall be such, as may be prescribed.

6. **Salaries and allowances to be paid out of grants.**- The salaries and allowances payable to the Chairman and Members and the administrative expenses including salaries, allowances and pensions payable to the officers and other employees referred to in section 5 shall be paid out of the grants referred to in sub-section (1) of section 12.

7. **Vacancies etc., not to invalidate proceedings of the Commission.**- No act or proceedings of the Commission shall be invalid merely on the ground of the existence of any vacancy or defect in the Constitution of the Commission.

8. **Procedure to be regulated by the Commission.**- (1) The Commission shall meet as and when necessary, Ordinarily at Bangalore and such other places as the Chairperson may think fit.

(2) The Commission shall regulate its own procedure.

(3) All orders and decisions of the Commission shall be authenticated by the Member-Secretary or any other officer of the Commission duly authorised by the Member-Secretary in this behalf.

### CHAPTER III

#### FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF THE COMMISSION

9. **Functions of the Commission.**- (1) The functions of the Commission shall be as follows:-

(i) to examine requests for inclusion of any class of citizens as a Backward Class in the lists and hear complaints of over inclusion or under inclusion of any Backward Class in such lists and tender such advice to the State Government as it deems appropriate;

(ii) to make the survey of the social and educational conditions and problems of the people belonging to the Backward Classes;

(iii) to supervise the implementation of various welfare schemes meant for the Backward Classes;

(2) The advice of the Commission shall ordinarily be binding upon the Government.

10. **Powers of the Commission.**- The Commission shall, while performing its functions under sub-section (1) of section 9, have all the powers of a civil court trying a suit and in particular, in respect of the following matters, namely:-

(a) summoning and enforcing the attendance of any person from any part of the State and examining him on oath;

(b) requiring the discovery and production of any document;

(c) receiving evidence on affidavits;

(d) requisitioning any public record or copy thereof from any court or office;

(e) issuing commissions for the examination of witnesses and documents; and

(f) any other matter which may be prescribed.





**11. Periodic revision of lists by the State Government.-** (1) The State Government may at any time, and shall, at the expiration of ten years from the coming into force of this Act and every succeeding period of ten years thereafter, undertake revision of the lists with a view to excluding from such lists those classes who have ceased to be backward classes or for including in such lists, new backward classes.

(2) The State Government shall, while undertaking any revision referred to in sub-section (1), consult the Commission.

## CHAPTER IV

### FINANCE, ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

**12. Grants by the State Government.-** The State Government shall after due appropriation made by the State Legislature by law in this behalf, pay to the Commission by way of grants such sums of money as the State Government may think fit, for being utilised for the purposes of this Act.

(2) The Commission may spend such sums as it thinks fit for performing the functions under this Act, and such sums shall be treated as expenditure payable out of the grants referred to in sub-section (1).

**13. Accounts and Audit.-** (1) Accounts of the income and expenditure of the Commissions shall be kept in accordance with such rules, as may be prescribed.

(2) The Commission shall prepare an annual statement of accounts in such form as may be prescribed.

(3) The accounts of the Commission shall be audited annually by such auditor as the State Government may appoint.

(4) The auditor shall, for the purpose of the audit, have access to all the accounts and other records of the Commission.

(5) The Commission shall pay from its grant such charges for the audit, as may be prescribed.

(6) As soon as may be after the receipt of the report of the auditor the Commission shall send a copy of the annual statement of accounts together with a copy of the report of the auditor to the State Government and shall cause to be published the annual statement of accounts in such manner, as may be prescribed.

(7) The State Government may after perusal of the report of the auditor give directions as it thinks fit to the Commission and the Commission shall comply with such directions.

**14. Annual Report.-** The Commission shall prepare, in such form and at such time, for each financial year, as may be prescribed, its annual report, giving a full account of its activities during the previous financial year and forward a copy thereof to the State Government.

**15. Annual report and audit report to be laid before the State Legislature.-** The State Government shall cause the annual report together with a memorandum of action taken on the recommendation contained therein so far as they relate to the State and the reasons for the non-acceptance of such recommendations, to be laid, as soon as may be, after the



reports are received, before each House of the State Legislature. The Commission may at its discretion submit from time to time special report on any matter of public importance to the state Government.

## CHAPTER V

### MISCELLANEOUS

16. Chairman, Members and employees of the Commission to be public servants.- The Chairman, members and employees of the Commission shall be deemed to be public servants within the meaning of section 21 of the Indian Penal Code.

17. Power to make rules.- (1) The State Government may by notification in the Official Gazette make rules for carrying out the provisions of this Act.

(2) In particular, and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers, such rules may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-

(a) salaries and allowances payable to, and the other terms and conditions of service of the Chairman and members under sub-section (5) of section 4 and the officers and other employees under sub-section (2) of section 5.

(b) the form in which the annual statement of accounts shall be prepared under sub-section (2) of section 13;

(c) the form in, and the time at which the annual report shall be prepared under section 14;

(d) any other matter which is required to be, or may be prescribed.

(3) Every rule made under this Act shall be laid as soon as may be after it is made, before each House of State Legislature while it is in session, for a total period of thirty days which may be comprised in one session or in two or more successive sessions, and if, before the expiry of the session immediately following the session or the successive sessions aforesaid, both Houses agree in making any modification in the rule or both Houses agree that the rule should not be made, the rule shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be, so however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done under that rule.

18. Power to remove difficulties.- (1) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of this Act, the State Government may by order, published in the Official Gazette make provisions not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act as appear to it to be necessary or expedient, for removing the difficulty;

Provided that no such order shall be made after the expiry of a period of two years from the date of commencement of this Act.

(2) Every order under this section shall as soon as may be after it is made, be laid before each House of the State Legislature.

### NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 17 of the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1995 (Karnataka Act 28 of 1995), The Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

#### 1. Title and Commencement:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes Rules, 1999.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

#### 2. Definitions:- In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- (1) 'Act' means the Karnataka State Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1995 (Karnataka Act 28 of 1995)
- (2) 'Chairman' means the Chairman of the Commission nominated by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Act :
- (3) 'Government' means the Government of Karnataka.

#### 3. Salary and Allowance of the Chairman, Members and Staff of the Commission:-

- (1) The Chairman shall be entitled to the pay and allowances including traveling and daily allowance etc. as per applicable to a High Court Judge and are in force from time to time.
- (2) The members other than the Member Secretary, shall be entitled to salary, allowances, traveling allowance and daily allowance etc., as in force from time to time and applicable to the Members of the Karnataka Public Service Commission.



(3) The posts of the Commission shall be filled by deputation of the officers/officials having equivalent pay scales and grade, from any of the State Civil Services / Universities / Local Authorities / Public Sector Undertakings / Statutory Boards / Corporations or by way of Contract appointments persons retired on superannuation from any of the above services.

(4) The appointments on deputation and contract appointments shall be as per the provisions of the Karnataka Civil Services Rules, the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 and any other orders of Government in force from time to time.
